2010 Project Safe Neighborhoods Anti-Gang Initiative Grant Award

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of accepting the 2010 Project Safe Neighborhoods Anti-Gang Initiative Grant Award. Through the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Southern District of Iowa, the Police Department has applied for and has been awarded this grant.

Amount: \$20,138 reimbursement grant. No matching funds required.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Project Safe Neighborhoods 2010 Anti-Gang Initiative provides funding to support new and expanded anti-gang prevention and enforcement efforts. The program is being administered through the State of Iowa Office of Drug Control Policy for the U.S. Department of Justice. The grant is for a two-year period from October 01, 2010 through June 30, 2013.

The Police Department will use this funding for a police supervisor and for officer overtime working in the Homes of Oakridge complex for increased police presence to address gang activity and related crimes. The funds will also be used for overtime in expanded gang prevention and enforcement efforts city-wide.
