The Iowa Department of Economic Development awarded CDBG Disaster Recovery Infrastructure funds to the City of Des Moines, IA for two projects:

- 2) \$2,000,000 for Storm Water Pump Station North of the Des Moines River Levee between S.E. 4th St. and S.E. 9th St.
