AGENDA HEADING:

Resolution Approving the Younkers Building, L.L.C. Application for Enterprise Zone Benefits for a Housing Project in the City of Des Moines

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the application as follows: Younkers Building, L.L.C. (Alexander Company, Inc., 145 East Badger Road Suite 200, Madison, Wisconsin 55713) for Enterprise Zone benefits for a \$42.5M project constructing 143 residential units at 713 Walnut Street in the Gateway Enterprise Zone.

FISCAL IMPACT: NONE

These are State of Iowa tax credits and have no impact on the general fund of the City of Des Moines. All are funded by the State of Iowa Enterprise Zone program.

\$ 2,674,300 Investment Tax Credit; \$ 200,000 Sales Tax Refund

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Younkers Building, L.L.C. project will reintroduce the historic Younkers building to active use in downtown Des Moines, providing needed workforce housing and contributing to the enhancement of the Central Business District. The project provides an adaptive reuse of an existing structure, connects to the skywalk system and bus routes, and when completed, will score in the highest green criteria tier under the Iowa Green Streets Program.
