### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approval of 158 tax abatement applications for improvements to property completed in 2010.

#### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of a total of 158 tax abatement applications with an estimated value of \$20,804,306.24. There were 48 applications for the construction of new single family homes, apartments and new commercial buildings with an estimated value of \$16,951,854 and 110 applications for improvements to existing structures with an estimated value of \$3,852,452.24.

# FISCAL IMPACT: [SELECT ONE]

Amount: Abatement upon property with a claimed value of \$20,804,306.24.

<u>Funding Source</u>: Taxes will only be generated from the land value while tax abatement is in effect. Taxes on the \$20,804,306.24 improvement value will be forth coming when the improvement value comes on the tax rolls after abatement ends.

### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The applicant must increase the value of residential property at least 5% for residential or 15% for commercial and industrial property to receive tax abatement.

Of the 158 applications submitted for approval by this roll call:

Eighty seven applicants chose Schedule 1 with an estimated value of \$1,447,630.38. Schedule 1 is for residential property with a ten year exemption from the taxation on the actual value of improvements not to exceed \$20,000. The exemption amount is 115% of the actual value added by improvements.

Two applicants chose Schedule 2 with an estimated value of \$55,000.00. Schedule 2 is for all qualified real estate and will receive a partial exemption for ten years. The exemption schedule is a declining schedule starting with the first year at 80% and ending in year ten at 20%.

No applicants chose Schedule 3 with an estimated value of \$0.00. All qualified real estate is eligible to receive an exemption from taxation on the actual value added by the improvements for three years. This schedule also applies to commercial and industrial property in specific areas.

Thirteen applicants chose Schedule 4A with an estimated value of \$9,640,231. Schedule 4A is for qualified real estate in specific areas generally located downtown and near the downtown area. The exemption period is ten years and the exemption amount is 100% of the actual value added by improvements. Qualified real estate assessed as residential or assessed as commercial consisting of three or more living quarters with at least 75% of the space used residentially is eligible to receive an exemption from taxation and the actual value added by the improvements.

Fifty-six applicants chose Schedule 4B with an estimated value of \$9,661,444.86. Schedule 4B is for qualified real estate for the remainder of the City for a period of five years. Qualified real estate assessed as residential or commercial and consisting of three or more living quarters with at least 75% of the space used residentially is eligible to receive an exemption from taxation on the actual value added by improvements. The exemption amount is 100% of the actual value added by the improvements.
