AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Articles of Agreement for Sub-Grant # 2010-SS-T0-0031-20 (Cyber Risk Reduction) with the Iowa Homeland Security and Emergency Management Division.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Articles of Agreement for Sub-Grant # 2010-SS-T0-0031-20 (Cyber Risk Reduction). The Iowa Homeland Security and Emergency Management Director has requested the City of Des Moines serve as the fiscal agent and authorized representative for the administration of this sub-grant on behalf of the State of Iowa Information Security Office.

This project will develop a system to provide automated network and web application vulnerability scanning capabilities for any Iowa school or government entity that requests it. The system will test, prioritize and report on existing vulnerabilities so the appropriate action can be taken.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$312,378

Funding Source: U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Grant Programs Directorate, FFY2010 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP). There is no local match required for the grants.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

If approved by Council, the City of Des Moines, as the sub-grantee, will provide all supervision, inspection, accounting, and other services necessary to complete the scope of work for the investments from inception to closeout as described in the Articles of Agreement.
