**AGENDA HEADING:**

Approval of Iowa Chapter 28D Agreement Renewal for Employee Interchange between the Des Moines Police Department and the Polk County Sheriff's Office.

**SYNOPSIS:**

On January 26, 2009 the City Council approved an agreement for an employee interchange from the Des Moines Police Department to the Polk County Sheriff's Office concerning Lieutenant Allan Tunks on roll call 09-113. The agreement was for a term of twenty four (24) months from the date of execution. On January 26, 2011, the term of that agreement will terminate. The Iowa Code Section 28D.3 allows for this agreement to be renewed for another twenty four (24) month period. Lieutenant Tunks has indicated a willingness to continue as the subject of the exchange as have the City and the County. It is the desire of the Police Department that the City Council approve, accept and authorize the Mayor to sign a Renewal Agreement created by the City Legal Department.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

On January 26, 2009 the City Council approved an agreement for an employee interchange from the Des Moines Police Department to the Polk County Sheriff's Office concerning Lieutenant Allan Tunks. Lieutenant Tunks was assigned to the Sheriff's Detective Bureau. He has extensive training and experience in major crimes and investigations. His assignment was created to enhance area law enforcement and provide an opportunity for Des Moines and Polk County to continue a high level of cooperation.

The initial employee interchange agreement has expired and the City, County and Lieutenant Tunks are willing to renew this agreement for another twenty four (24) months. Lieutenant Tunks will continue in his position as Chief of Investigations-Second Deputy Sheriff.

All of the duties, obligations, and other conditions of the Agreement between the City of Des Moines, Iowa and Polk County, IA entered into on the 27th day of January 2009 are incorporated into the new renewal agreement.
