# **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

This grant award will be administered by the City of Des Moines Police Department for the twenty county area referred to as Law Enforcement Intelligence Network (LEIN) Region 5. This is a continuation of a collaborative effort coordinated with other local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies to share and analyze terrorism related intelligence data. The recipient agrees that funds utilized are to enhance effectiveness of the Iowa Intelligence Fusion Center and the Regional Fusion Office and must support the development of a statewide fusion process that corresponds with the Global Justice/Homeland Security Advisory Council (HSAC) Fusion Center Guidelines and achievement of a baseline level of capability as defined by the Fusion Capability Planning Tool. Grant Performance Period is October 1, 2010 to June 30, 2013.
