## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Des Moines Community Action Agency is in contact with potentially eligible people and has been identified as a partner for this program. The income and resource guidelines for the low-income energy assistance programs administered by Des Moines Community Action Agency parallel the income and resource guidelines for the LIS. All energy assistance clients must reapply for assistance with screening guidelines similar to those for LIS. Potential clients will be screened for eligibility and will be assisted in completing the LIS applications.

The City shall be paid \$25.00 for each confirmed LIS application submitted for a client applying for LIS through the contract term until a total amount paid reaches \$5,000. This will provide for a total of 200 eligible applications under the terms and conditions set forth in the Contract.
