Dave Chiodo, (NR-0), Senior Police Officer, to Kansas City, MO, from February 27 – March 3, 2011, (\$1,364.36), to receive training to become certified in underwater bridge inspection. This training will benefit the City of Des Moines by expanding the pool of divers available to perform these inspections.

The inspections must be performed by FHWA-approved bridge inspectors. The registration cost of \$860 will be paid through the Bridges Capital Project fund, with the remaining \$504.36 being paid from Federally Forfeited Funds.

T.M. Franklin Cownie, (R-9), Mayor, to Las Vegas, NV, from March 6 – March 7, 2011, (\$0), to serve as keynote speaker at the 2011 City & County Performance Summit. All expenses will be paid by the meeting sponsor.

T.M. Franklin Cownie, (R-9), Mayor, to Shepherdstown, WV, on February 22, 2011, (\$1,485), to attend the National Green Infrastructure Conference 2011 as a representative of the National Urban and Community Forestry Advisory Council. Also, to Washington, D.C., on February 23, 2011, to attend the U.S. Conference of Mayors 2011 Winter Leadership Meeting regarding setting Congressional Budget allocations for 2011 & 2012. Funding will focus on issues facing low-income populations, including jobs, job training, access to quality education and healthcare.

Jeff Dawon, (NR-0), Senior Police Officer, to Kansas City, MO, from February 27 – March 3, 2011, (\$1,364.36), to receive training to become certified in underwater bridge inspection. This training will benefit the City of Des Moines by expanding the pool of divers available to perform these inspections. The inspections must be performed by FHWA-approved bridge inspectors. The registration cost of \$860 will be paid through the Bridges Capital Project fund, with the remaining \$504.36 being paid from Federally Forfeited Funds.

Mark Durham, (NR-0), ERP Project Manager, to Reno, NV, from March 20 – March 24, 2011, (\$1,600), to attend GFOA training on Financial & ERP Systems selection and implementation.

This training will benefit the City of Des Moines by expanding the pool of divers available to perform these inspections. The inspections must be performed by FHWA-approved bridge inspectors. David Seybert, (NR-1), Sergeant, to Myrtle Beach, SC, from March 19 – March 23, 2011, (\$1,508), to attend training sponsored by the Thomas and Means Law Firm on Managing Police Discipline. The course is directed towards internal affair investigators and focuses on managing police discipline, internal affairs investigations, due process requirements, "Brady" rule developments, and other related topics.

Adam Smith, (NR-0), Sewer Operations Manager, to Spokane, WA, from April 9 – April 13, 2011, (\$1,565.16), to attend the American Public Works Association (APWA)/Pacific Northwest Snowfighters Association (PNS) combined snow conference. The APWA is the public works community's number one resource for information and expertise on winter operations, and PNS is renowned for their technical expertise in snow and ice. This partnership brings snowfighters from across the U.S. and Canada together to showcase four days of quality educational programs and technical tours with opportunities to see the newest equipment and products available, and to exchange ideas with manufacturers, distributors, consultants, and other public works professionals.
