AGENDA HEADING:

Public hearing on a municipal lease for the purchase of three catch basin cleaners for the Public Works Department.

SYNOPSIS:

Public hearing on February 28, 2011, to consider lease-purchasing three catch basin cleaners for the Public Works Department. This action initiates the financing process for this equipment acquisition.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: Not to exceed \$1,150,000, plus interest.

<u>Funding Source</u>: FY 2011 Operating Budget, Sewer Maintenance, Sanitary Sewer Fund, EN101, PWK071000, page 262.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The City utilizes the lease-purchase program to finance vehicles and equipment as a means to avoid large one-time expenditures. Previously, the City utilized a master lease agreement that was awarded under a separate contract. However, due to changes in the economy over the past few years, the City has not been able to secure a master lease relationship with a financial institution through the request for proposals (RFP) process. In accordance with the City's procurement ordinance, the City can negotiate a lease-purchase arrangement when the RFP process yields no responses. As such, the Finance Department intends to negotiate a lease-purchase arrangement with the vendor who is awarded the equipment contract.
