#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approving and Authorizing Execution of Agreements for Electrical Service with MidAmerican Energy, in conjunction with the Court Avenue Pump Stations Project, not to exceed \$34,974.49.

#### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of the Refundable Advance for Construction Underground Electric Service Extension Agreement with MidAmerican Energy, not to exceed \$34,974.49, for a three-phase underground electric line for the Court Avenue pump station included in the Court Avenue and Water Street Storm Water Pump Station project.

#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The Court Avenue and Water Street Storm Water Pump Station project is part of the Court Avenue & Water Street Sewer Separating project, which includes construction of a separate storm sewer system, and this storm water pump station to serve this area. This area of downtown is currently served by a combined (storm and sanitary) sewer system, resulting in localized flooding during heavy rain events, especially during high river levels. The Court Avenue and Water Street Storm Water Pump Station project provides for the construction of a pump station to provide increased flood protection behind the levee system during periods of high river levels.

MidAmerican Energy will extend a three-phase electric line underground to the proposed pump station at Water Street and Court Avenue. MidAmerican Energy will furnish the necessary labor and materials required to extend a three-phase electric line underground to said pump station. The amount of \$34,974.49 is an advance for construction subject to refund, which represents the full amount due from the City of Des Moines for the extension of a three-phase electric line underground to the proposed pump station.
