AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: Evergreen & Columbus Parks Basketball Court Improvements - Receiving bids, (5-10-11), and Setting date of hearing, (5-23-11). (Construction Estimate - \$70,000).

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project will install new basketball goals at Evergreen & Columbus Parks and a new basketball court at Evergreen Park.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Evergreen & Columbus Parks Basketball Court Improvements, 11-2011-002. The improvement includes the installation of new basketball goals, PCC flatwork, earthwork and restoration; all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File Nos. 531-024/027, located at Evergreen Park, 2000 Evergreen Avenue, and at Columbus Park, 1921 SE 1st Street, Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$70,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
