AGENDA HEADING:

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend to receive and file report from City Manager regarding Contractor Qualification Questionnaire presented at the April 11, 2011, City Council Meeting. The report outlines potential benefits and drawbacks from utilizing the questionnaire, as well as a brief background on previous qualification questionnaires.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The attached report contains a brief analysis of the Contractor Qualification Questionnaire presented at the April 11, 2011, City Council Meeting. If such a questionnaire were to be used to determine which contractor's bids would be considered, a set of rules, regulations, and criteria for implementation must be developed. The brief discussion at the April 11, 2011 Council meeting, indicated a desire to include effected stakeholders in any implementation strategy. If City Council decides to try and implement the presented questionnaire, or similar questionnaire, a discussion at a City Council Workshop may be warranted. If directed, City Staff could solicit input from construction companies, bonding companies, labor groups, local contracting agencies and other interested parties on the questionnaire and present the results at a City Council Workshop mid-summer.
