ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The City Council approved the 2010 SHP application on November 8, 2010, by Roll Call No. 10-1845. Included in the application were two renewals for \$30,265 and \$76,136 for the West Des Moines Human Services Transitional Housing Program.

West Des Moines Human Services has been providing assistance to those in need in the community since 1979. The West Des Moines Transitional Housing Program began in August 2000 to provide housing and support services for homeless families with dependent children.
