AGENDA HEADING:

Continuation of public hearing upon application of City Cab LLC for Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate a Taxicab Service in the City of Des Moines.

SYNOPSIS:

Shani Amin and Mohamed Ahmed, d/b/a City Cab LLC, 100 East Euclid Avenue, Suite E, Des Moines, Iowa 50313, have applied for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate a taxicab service in the City of Des Moines, with a total of six vehicles. Staff has reviewed the application and the liability insurance certificate and has determined that City Cab LLC meets the requirements for providing taxicab service. As required by ordinance, a public hearing must be held prior to any certificate being issued.

At their February 28, 2011 meeting, by Roll Call No. 11-0326, the City Council continued the public hearing for City Cab LLC to May 9, 2011. Traffic and Transportation staff has reviewed the application and supplemental information provided by City Cab, and has determined that no false or misleading information was submitted in the application. In addition, the Police Department has reviewed the allegations regarding illegal use of a credit card, and has determined that there is no evidence found of criminal activity.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: The ordinance provides for annual license fees of \$250 per company and \$75 per vehicle.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

At their April 11, 2011 meeting, by Roll Call No. 11-0621, the City Council continued the public hearing for City Cab LLC to May 9, 2011. Traffic and Transportation staff has reviewed the application and supplemental information provided by City Cab, and has determined that no false or misleading information was submitted in the application. In addition, the Police Department has reviewed the allegations regarding illegal use of a credit card, and has determined that there is no evidence found of criminal activity. Based on this further review of the application, City Cab LLC meets the requirements for providing taxicab service.

Section 126-186 provides if the Council finds at the conclusion of the public hearing that further taxicab

service in the City of Des Moines, or between any point or points in the City and elsewhere, is required by the public convenience and necessity and the applicant is fit, willing and able to perform such public transportation and to conform to the provisions of the subchapter, then the Council shall direct the City Traffic Engineer to issue a certificate stating the name and address of the applicant, the number of vehicles authorized under said certificate and the date of issuance; otherwise, the section provides the application shall be denied.

Section 126-186(a) provides that in making the findings of subsection (b) of said section, the Council shall take into consideration the number of taxicabs already in operation, whether existing transportation is adequate to meet the public need, the probable effect of increased service on local traffic conditions, and the character, experience and responsibility of the applicant.
