**AGENDA HEADING:**

Approval of Amendment #1 to the FY2008 Weapons of Mass Destruction Tactical Officers Grant.

**SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of Amendment No. 1 to the original grant agreement which changes the performance period of the FY2008-GE-T8-2008-021-SWAT Grant. The approved performance period was from 20 October, 2009 through March 31, 2011 and now has a new end date of June 30, 2011. The change in the end date will allow all work to be completed and all grant funds expended. There are no other changes to the grant other than the performance period end date.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: The grant award from the State of Iowa Homeland Security and Emergency Management Division is \$709,480. There is no requirement for a local match.

Funding Source: Grant proceeds are deposited into FY11-12 Recommended Operating Budget SP751, POL985312, Grant Page 249.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

This grant award is administered by the City of Des Moines for the WMD-SWAT Tactical Officers Leadership Taskforce which comprises of six WMD-SWAT Tactical Officers Teams throughout the state of Iowa.
