AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: Fire Station Emergency Generator, HVAC, and Sprinkler Improvements - Receiving bids, (5-24-11), and Setting date of hearing, (6-13-11). (Construction Estimate - \$729,600).

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project will replace old, undersized emergency generators at Stations 2 thru 10. Sprinklers and a smoke/fire alarm notification system will be installed at the four remaining stations without these systems (No. 2, 5, 7 and 9). Also the old, inefficient HVAC systems will be upgraded at Stations 2, 5, 6, and 7 as an add-alternate.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Des Moines Fire Department will use City funds in conjunction with the 2009 Assistance to Firefighter Grant (AFG) award from Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMS), and US Department of Homeland Security (DHS) for the purchase of 9 generators, sprinkler and monitoring systems for Fire Stations 2, 5, 7, and 9.

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Fire Station Emergency Generator, HVAC, and Sprinkler Improvements, 10-2011-001. The improvement includes installation of emergency generators, HVAC improvements, sprinkler & fire alarm improvements, and other incidental items; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plans File Nos. 531-145/190, at the following locations in Des Moines, Iowa: Station No. 2 - 1727 E. Walnut Street; Station No. 3 - 2458 Easton Blvd.; Station No. 4 - 917 University Avenue; Station No. 5 - 711 42nd Street; Station No. 6 - 1919 SE 6th Street; Station No. 7 -

3500 E 12th Street; Station No. 8 - 1249 McKinley Avenue; Station No. 9 - 4800 Douglas Avenue; and Station No. 10 - 5900 Indianola Rd.

The estimated construction cost is \$729,600. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
