Amount: \$11,000 plus closing costs



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On September 11, 2006, City Council approved the Amended Forest Avenue Urban Renewal Plan. The King Irving Neighborhood has a large number of vacant lots scattered throughout the area. The Amended Urban Renewal Plan allows for the acquisition of these lots for redevelopment.

This property consists of two vacant lots that contain approximately 14,904 square feet. The purchase of these lots will allow the City to redevelop them in accordance with the Forest Avenue Urban Renewal Plan.

Comaletta G. Smart, 7131 South Wenatchee Way, Unit H, Aurora, Colorado, 80016-4055, is the titleholder of the vacant lots located at 1603 13th Street. The fair market value of these lots is \$11,000 as determined by an independent appraisal.
