AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 2011 City-wide PCC Pavement Restoration Program - Receiving bids, (6-14-11), and Setting date of hearing, (6-27-11). (Construction Estimate - \$224,500).

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for timely maintenance of Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) residential and arterial streets utilizing full depth removal and replacement of distressed panels to improve the surface condition and extend the useful life of the streets.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2011 City-wide PCC Pavement Restoration Program, 06-2011-009. The improvements includes furnishing, placing, curing, sawing, and sealing PCC Pavement Patches of various thickness in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines, Public Works Department, at the following locations:

E. 42nd Street from Hubbell Avenue to Boyd Street SW 62nd Street from Tonka Avenue to Railroad Avenue Adams Avenue from 34th Street to dead-end East E. Douglas Avenue from E. 38th Street to E. 42nd Street Kingman Circle from Kingman Boulevard to cul-de-sac South SW Leland Avenue from Hwy 28 to SW 63rd Street Park Lawn Avenue from SW 42nd Street to 1600' West E. Rose Avenue from SE 15th Street to Indianola Drive Twana Drive from 50th Street to 4928 Twana Drive Walker Avenue from E. 29th Street to E. 30th Street.

The estimated construction cost is \$224,500. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
