This action is required by Iowa law before the City can initiate right-of-way acquisition process under eminent domain.

## FISCAL IMPACT:



# **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

This project provides for improvements at three intersections along Euclid Avenue. At the intersection of Euclid Avenue and 11th Street, a new traffic signal is planned to be installed. At the intersection of Euclid Avenue and Oxford Street and Euclid Avenue and Cornell Street, minor widening of the existing roadway is planned to allow for the installation of left-turn lanes and new traffic signals or traffic signal upgrades. At the intersection of Euclid Avenue and Oxford Street, an existing fence and planter will be relocated for site-distance. No other improvements will be made at this intersection.

Several partial fee acquisitions and temporary construction easements will be required for construction of this project. In accordance with the agreements with the Iowa Department of Transportation for this project, all permanent property interests will be acquired by the City in the name of the State of Iowa for incorporation into the existing right-of-way for U.S. Highway 6. Relocation assistance will not be required for this project.
