#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approval to purchase additional shelf capacity and disk drives for Mass Storage Expansion of the City's shared storage unit from Vital Support Systems (11191 Aurora Avenue, Urbandale, IA 50322).

#### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval for the purchase of an additional drive shelf and additional disk drives to expand the current mass storage system. Vital Support Systems was the only bidder. Seven bids were mailed but only one was received. (Bid No. V11-081)

#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The Mass Storage system used by the city is running low on disk space and needs additional disk capacity to handle current and future needs. This mass storage system was installed in October of 2007 with one unit at the Airport and one unit at the Armory building. This additional storage will provide support of current files and will allow the continued conversion of physical servers to virtual servers.
