AGENDA HEADING:

Approving and authorizing the execution of Iowa Department of Transportation Agreement No. 2012-TS-008 for the Citywide Fixed-Time Traffic Signal Upgrading Project.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) Agreement No. 2012-TS-008 for Traffic Safety Improvement Program funds, for the Citywide Fixed-Time Traffic Signal Upgrading Project (IDOT Project No. CS-TSF-1945(784)—85-77).

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: The total estimated project cost is \$520,000. IDOT has approved \$80,000 of Traffic Safety Improvement Program funds, along with an additional \$320,000 of Iowa Clean Air Attainment Program (ICAAP) funds. The City of Des Moines' estimated cost is \$120,000.

<u>Funding Source</u>: Various funding sources as follows:

- \$80,000 Iowa DOT Traffic Safety Improvement Program Funds
- \$320,000 Iowa Clean Air Attainment Program Funds
- \$120,000 2011-12 CIP, Page Street-46, Traffic Signals, Channelization, and School Crossings, TFC091, Activity ID 04-2011-002, G.O. Bonds

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

This project consists of upgrading the traffic signal operation at 21 existing intersections that currently operate as fixed-time signals. The locations are along four of the City's more important traffic-carrying corridors—2nd Avenue, University Avenue, Grand Avenue, and Keo Way. The proposed project would involve installation of vehicle detectors on the side street, and left-turning phases, along with adding pedestrian push-buttons, thereby maximizing the amount of green time available for the major roadway. The total project cost is \$520,000, which consists of \$440,000 construction and \$80,000 for design and right-of-way. The IDOT has approved \$320,000 of Iowa Clean Air Attainment Program funds and also \$80,000 from Traffic Safety Funds. This project is being designed by Traffic and Transportation Division staff so no consultants are being used on this project.
