# AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on Fire Station Emergency Generator, HVAC, and Sprinkler Improvements: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Biermann's University Electric Company, Inc., Gary P. Cornelius, President, \$656,763.

## SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Fire Station Emergency Generator, HVAC, and Sprinkler Improvements and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project will replace old, undersized emergency generators at Stations 2 thru 9. Sprinklers and a smoke/fire alarm notification system will be installed at the four remaining stations without these systems (No. 2, 5, 7 and 9). The add-alternate to upgrade the HVAC systems at Stations 2, 5, 6, and 7 was not accepted.

### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**
