AGENDA HEADING:

Continued hearing for conveyance of a License Agreement on City-owned property at 1012 Oak Park Avenue (McHenry Park) to Qwest Corporation for \$200.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval for conveyance of a License Agreement on City-owned property at 1012 Oak Park Avenue (McHenry Park) to Qwest Corporation, Bill Geneser, Ulteig Engineers, 215 East 21st Street, Madrid, IA, 50156 for \$200. This action is required by Iowa law prior to making a final determination on the proposed conveyance by resolution. The City will not be inconvenienced by approval of the negotiated License Agreement.


FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$200 Revenue

<u>Funding Source</u>: Sale proceeds will be deposited into the Property Maintenance Endowment Fund, SP767, ENG980500. The first \$175,000 of annual proceeds to the Property Maintenance Endowment Fund will be returned to the General Fund (GE001, ENG040700) to offset the operating budget of the Engineering – Real Estate Division.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Qwest Corporation owns and operates fiber optic equipment and lines within the street right-of-way of Oak Park Avenue that must be relocated. Qwest Corporation has requested a license agreement to use City-owned property at 1012 Oak Park Avenue (McHenry Park) for the relocation and for the placement of related utility equipment. The license area measures 17' by 14' for approximately 238 square feet, and the negotiated license agreement establishes a 15-year term commencing upon execution of the agreement by the City through April 30, 2026. The one-time lump sum payment of \$200 reflects the fair market value of the licensed area, as currently established by the City's Real Estate Division. The City can terminate the license agreement for cause, immediately upon notice, and without cause upon 120 days notice. Upon termination of the license agreement, Qwest is required to remove all improvements to the licensed area.
