## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

On June 9, 2008, the City Council approved and accepted the original bond for infrastructure improvements in the amount of \$22,254 for the Airport Industrial Park Plat 2 subdivision. A reduction of the existing subdivision improvement bond and the acceptance of a subsequent bond rider for the remaining work was approved by City Council on January 24, 2011. The developer has requested a release of the remainder of the required surety since all of the grading and subdivision improvement work has now been satisfactorily completed.

Airport Industrial Park Plat 2 is located in the vicinity of the 4300 Block of SW 63rd Street and consists of one 16 acre development parcel and several outlots for future development. The Mid-Iowa Council of the Boy Scouts of America has purchased the development parcel within the plat, and intends to build the 30,000 sq. ft. Fred Maytag II Scout Center, consisting of collaborative conference space and an administrative office wing, among other scouting-related activities.
