AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2011 Citywide PCC Pavement Restoration Program: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer’s estimate, receive and file bids and designating lowest responsible bidder as Absolute Concrete Construction, Inc., Sonny E. Hall, President, P.O. Box 148, Slater, IA 50244, \$213,870.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for input on the 2011 Citywide PCC Pavement Restoration Program and take the necessary actions, as required by Iowa Code, to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for timely maintenance of Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) on residential and arterial streets utilizing full depth removal and replacement of distressed panels to improving the surface condition and extending the useful life of the streets.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$213,870 Construction Contract (\$224,500 City Engineer's Estimate)

Funding Source: 2011-2012 CIP, Concrete Paving Restoration Program - Public Works, STR102, Page Street - 8, G. O. Bonds.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On May 23, 2011, under Roll Call No. 11-0862, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2011 Citywide PCC Pavement Restoration Program. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2011 Citywide PCC Pavement Restoration Program, 06-2011-009. The improvement includes furnishing, placing, curing, sawing and sealing PCC pavement patches of various thickness in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines, Public Works Department, at the following locations:

- E. 42nd Street from Hubbell Avenue to Boyd Street
- S.W. 62nd Street from Tonka Avenue to Railroad Avenue
- Adams Avenue from 34th Street to dead-end East
- E. Douglas Avenue from E. 38th Street to E. 42nd Street
- Kingman Circle from Kingman Boulevard to cul-de-sac South
- S.W. Leland Avenue from Hwy. 28 to S.W. 63rd Street

Park Lawn Avenue from S.W. 42nd Street to 1600' West
E. Rose Avenue from S.E. 15th Street to Indianola Drive
Twana Drive from 50th Street to 4928 Twana Drive
Walker Avenue from E. 29th Street to E. 30th Street.

Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

Absolute Concrete Construction, Inc., Slater, IA
T K Concrete Inc., Pella, IA

The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, IA at 11:00 a.m. on June 14, 2011.

The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Absolute Concrete Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$213,870, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement, as stated above.
