AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of FY2010 Methamphetamine Drug Hot Spots Grant Program Award from the Governor’s Office of Drug Control Policy.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Des Moines Police Department’s grant award from the Governor’s Office of Drug Control Policy to be used for activities related to methamphetamine drug interdiction within the City of Des Moines.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$31,576. There is no match requirement for this grant.

Funding Source: U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services. Funds will be deposited in FY2012 Operating Budget, GE001, POL010700, Page 226.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Iowa Office of Drug Control Policy approached the Police Department regarding funding available to be directed towards activities related to methamphetamine drug interdiction within the City of Des Moines. The Police Department applied for and was awarded \$31,576. \$26,021 has been allocated for overtime for the Vice and Narcotics Control Section to working at various locations from July through December, 2011 performing activities related to interdiction of methamphetamine and other illegal drugs. Regular duty officers will be supplemented by officers working overtime in order to work the hours necessary to cause successful operations. \$5,555 was allocated for equipment to enhance the interdiction activities.

The grant period is from July 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011.
