AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of blanket purchase order to Great American Outdoors-South to obtain John Deere equipment repair parts as needed for fiscal year 2012.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of a blanket purchase order for the single-source non-competitive purchase of John Deere-brand equipment repair parts as needed from Great American Outdoors-South, Don Van Houweling, owner, 710 Army Post Road, Des Moines, IA 50315, sole source area-wide distributor of these parts in the area.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$40,000

Funding Source: FY2012 Operating Budget, GE001 PKS041000, page 186.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

This request is to authorize the Finance Department's Procurement Division to issue a FY 2012 blanket purchase order to Great American Outdoors for provision of John Deere mowing and other turf-care and small equipment repair parts as needed by the Park and Recreation Department for maintenance of this manufacturer's equipment, which is used extensively in the department's turf maintenance program. Although the number and cost of parts varies each year depending on such factors as amount of use and age of equipment, based on historical need, it is anticipated that the maximum expense necessary for FY2012 will be \$40,000.

Municipal Code Section 2-726 (a)(6) provides for a non-competitive procurement of repair parts when the required parts are available only from a single area-wide distributor and competitive bids for such parts are thus not prospectively attainable.
