### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Ordering construction of the following: Sargent Park Natural Playscape - Receiving bids, (8-16-11), and Setting date of hearing, (8-29-11). (Construction Estimate - \$240,000).

## **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the construction of a new natural playground including limestone retaining walls, logs, sidewalk, a cave, tunnel and water feature. A new shelter will also be constructed near the playground.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$240,000 City Engineer's Estimate

Funding Source: 2011-2012 CIP, Page Parks - 15, Park Redevelopment, PKS100, G. O. Bonds.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Sargent Park Natural Playscape, 11-2011-005. The improvement includes the installation of a new shelter, new natural playground including 5" PCC sidewalk, limestone retaining walls, earthwork, logs, a cave, tunnel, water feature, and restoration; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 534-74/80 at Sargent Park, 3530 E Douglas Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$240,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
