She currently has a seven year forgivable second mortgage in the amount of \$23,760 with the Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency. However, since she has lived in the home for more than seven years and has completed program requirements, City Legal has prepared a Release and Satisfaction of the Second Mortgage and staff is requesting authorization to execute and record the document.
