### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Set date of public hearing regarding request from Howard Tully, owner, to rezone property located at 201 SE 29th Street from "M-1" Light Industrial District to "R1-60" One-Family Low-Density Residential District (8/29/2011).

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The subject property is a 0.379 acre parcel. A single-family residential dwelling has existed on the subject property since 1972. The existing dwelling is considered a legal, non-conforming use in the "M-1" Light Industrial District. This designation is impacting the owner's ability to refinance the subject property. Properties immediately to the south of the subject property are zoned R1-60. The Plan and Zoning Commission will review and make recommendation on this zoning request on August 18, 2011. Councilmember Meyer has agreed to sponsor Council action to set the date of public hearing for August 29, 2011, due to the applicant's unique time constraints. Staff anticipates making a recommendation to the Plan and Zoning Commission to approve the necessary comprehensive plan amendment and zoning request. The Plan and Zoning Commission's recommendation will be forwarded to the City Council prior to the August 29, 2011 public hearing.
