AGENDA HEADING:

Approving agreement with Mid American Energy to attach City fiber to Mid American Energy utility poles.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of contract agreement between the City of Des Moines and Mid American Energy for the use of 26 poles to attach City fiber from Chesterfield Community Center, 2501 Maury, to the Public Works Supply Yard located at 922 SW 22nd and from SW 9th and Bell Avenue to Southview Manor located at 2417 SW 9th.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$750 one time cost and annual payment of \$5 per pole, for a cost of \$130 annually.

Funding Source: 2011-12 Operating Budget, Information Technology, IT-Telephone Communications IS033, IFT040000, Page 161.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The City needs to place City-owned fiber optics cable on Mid American Energy poles to provide network connectivity to the Public Works Supply Yard and Southview Manor. The connection at SW 9th and Bell will also allow the traffic signal at the intersection to connect to the City network. This agreement will require the City to pay Mid American Energy \$130 per year for use of these utility poles.
