AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the renewal of Websense Web Filter license from Insight Public Sector, 6820 South Harl Avenue, Tempe, AZ, 85283, for software used to filter Internet access by City employees.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of a three-year contract with Insight Public Sector for Websense Internet monitoring and filtering software. The City moved from an annual to a multi-year contract three years ago to realize cost savings. The annual renewal cost is \$24,992. The cost of the three year contract is \$45,320, which reduces the cost per year to \$15,107, and eliminates any annual price increases for the next three years.
