#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Resolution approving Amended Special Warranty Deed for conveyance to Kemin Holdings, L.C., as designee for Kemin Industries, Inc.

## **SYNOPSIS:**

On June 13, 2011, the City Council approved an Urban Renewal Development Agreement with Kemin Industries, Inc., whereby the City agreed to convey certain real estate to Kemin or its designee for an expansion of its corporate campus. After a portion of the real estate was conveyed to Kemin Holdings, L.C., the Polk County Auditor requested that the City file an Amended Special Warranty Deed to amend the legal description to conform with a Plat of Survey that was subsequently prepared for the property. This action approves the issuance of the Amended Special Warranty Deed.

#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

On June 13, 2011, by Roll Call No. 11-1048, after notice and public hearing, the City Council approved an Urban Renewal Development Agreement with Kemin Industries, Inc., for an expansion of the Kemin World-Wide Corporate Headquarters and Corporate Campus. The Agreement commits Kemin to expand its Des Moines facilities; a five-year capital expansion plan to be implemented under the Agreement consists of a new world-wide headquarters, new research & development facilities and six new manufacturing facilities. New construction is identified at a minimum of approximately 166,000 square feet. Kemin's investment in construction and site preparation is estimated at \$21.85 million, with an additional investment of \$6.3 million in manufacturing machinery and equipment, \$1.5 million in furniture and fixtures and \$10 million investment in new research and development. Kemin has growth plans to hire an additional 98 employees over the next five years at a projected weighted average starting wage of \$24.07, plus benefits. As of June 13th, Kemin employed 349 workers at its Des Moines location at an average wage of \$31.37 plus benefits, which it will retain in Des Moines.

The Agreement provides for the City to convey certain property to Kemin over four years beginning in 2011. The first parcels were conveyed to Kemin Holdings L.C., by a Special Warranty Deed dated July

12, 2011. Subsequent to the recording of that deed, the property was surveyed and described in a Plat of Survey recorded on October 26, 2011. The Polk County Auditor has requested that the City issue an Amended Special Warranty Deed to amend the legal descriptions used in that conveyance to conform with the Plat of Survey. City staff recommends that the City Council approve the Amended Special Warranty Deed.
