AGENDA HEADING:

Approving a Grant Agreement between the City of Des Moines on behalf of LEIN Region 5 Information Sharing Office (Sub Grantee) and the State of Iowa Homeland Security and Emergency Management Division for the FFY2011 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) National Infrastructure Protection Plan (NIPP).

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the FFY2011 Homeland Security Grant Agreement. The City of Des Moines, acting on behalf of LEIN Region 5 Information Sharing Office will act as fiscal agent to receive grant funding from the State Homeland Security Program (SHGP).

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$93,705.96

Funding Source: Grant proceeds will be deposited into SP751, POL980575, HSGP Grant (page 249, Adopted Budget for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2012.) There is no match requirement for this grant.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

This grant award will be administered by the City of Des Moines Police Department for the twenty county area referred to as Law Enforcement Intelligence Network (LEIN) Region 5. The Sub-Grantee agrees that funds utilized under this grant will apply to requirements for implementation of the National Infrastructure Protection Plan (NIPP). This includes steps involved in risk management framework, cooperation and collaboration with Critical Infrastructure and Key Resources partners. The performance period is October 1, 2011 to June 30, 2013.

Grant proceeds will be used to fund an existing City of Des Moines employee dedicated to perform the NIPP implementations.
