AGENDA HEADING:

Public hearings regarding the issuance of general obligation bonds for the FY 2012-13 Capital Improvement Budget.

SYNOPSIS:

Eight public hearings regarding the issuance of general obligation bonds for the FY 2012-13 Capital Improvement Budget. This is the first step in the process to finance the construction of capital projects totaling \$33.28 million. These hearings are being held in tandem with the approval of the budget so that the debt service payments associated with these projects can be included in the budget.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$33,830,000; made up of \$33,280,000 project costs and \$550,000 issuance expenses.

Funding Source: Fiscal Year 2012-13 Operating Budget:

- Property Tax Debt Service Levy – Debt Service Fund – DS001, FIN900100, Page 97;
- Tax Increment Fund – Special Revenue Fund – SP370, FIN909105, Page 98.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

A public hearing must be held prior to any borrowing by the City. This hearing is to consider bonding for the FY 2012-13 Capital Improvement Budget that will be submitted for approval by City Council on February 27, 2012. City staff reviewed projects that anticipated the availability of non-City funding to determine the certainty of those funds. The final sizing of the bonds will occur in April or May. Below is the current status of non-City funding related to the projects that will be funded in part with bond proceeds from this issuance.

- Easter Lake Drive Bridge over Branch of Easter Lake (\$245,000 Federal grant – Committed)
- Grand Avenue Bridge over Walnut Creek (\$1,000,000 Federal grant – Committed)
- Municipal Service Center (\$5,000,000 Federal grant – committed) – Transfer from STR249, SE Connector SE 14th – SE 30th
- Bicycle and Trails Master Plan Implementation (\$330,000 – State grant – Committed)
- Euclid Avenue Intersection Improvements (\$1,305,000 State grant – Committed)
- Indianola Avenue Widening (\$2 million Federal grant – Committed)
- SE Connector – SE 6th to SE 14th (\$6 million Federal grant – Committed)
- SE Connector – SE 14th to SE 30th (\$9.8 million in Fed. grants; and \$12.7 million RISE - Committed)
- Traffic Control Neighborhood Program (\$240,000 State grant – Committed)

Traffic Signals, Channelization and School Crossings (\$170,000 Federal grant – Committed; \$710,000 State grant – Committed)

Traffic Signal Interconnection (\$200,000 Federal grant – Committed)

City staff will continue to review general obligation funding needs to monitor if additional grant funding can reduce City debt issuance anticipated in April. Specific projects to be financed are detailed in a list at the end of this communication. Projects are summarized by category as follows:
