**AGENDA HEADING:**

Amending Chapter 114 of the Municipal Code regarding traffic regulation changes as follows:

A. Allowance of Left Turns at Hickman Road and 62nd Street and Addition of a Traffic Signal at Hickman Road and Westover Boulevard Due to the Recent Hickman Road Widening by the City of Windsor Heights.

**SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of the staff recommendations, including first reading of the Ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes.

The City of Windsor Heights recently completed a road widening project for Hickman Road which included improvements at the intersection of 62<sup>nd</sup> Street and the installation of a traffic signal at Hickman Road and Westover Boulevard. The ordinance changes below are needed to reflect the changes made with the Hickman Road project.

Sec. 114-320.01. Prohibited left turns.

(5) ~~Not Used. At the intersection of Hickman Road and Sixty-second Street, prohibiting left turns from eastbound Hickman Road to northbound Sixty-second Street, between 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday.~~

Sec. 114-1460. Hickman Road.

Hickman Road and Westover Boulevard, traffic control signal.
