AGENDA HEADING:

Approving and authorizing the execution of a 28E agreement with the City of West Des Moines for construction of the SW Connector by the City of West Des Moines.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the 28E Agreement with the City of West Des Moines for the construction of the SW Connector by West Des Moines.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: No City of Des Moines funding.

Funding Source: Federal and City of West Des Moines are funding the project.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The City of West Des Moines has been the sponsor for the SW Connector Roadway connecting the IA 5 Beltway to IA 28, which is partially in the City of Des Moines. The design of the SW Connector is consistent with the Long Range Transportation Plan. The portion being constructed connects to the Iowa Department of Transportation’s IA 28 Highway. This connection is within the City of Des Moines Corporate Limits, and does require a modification to McKinley Avenue, a City of Des Moines street. The proposed 28E Agreement allows the City of West Des Moines to construct these improvements at West Des Moines’ cost within the corporate limits of Des Moines. The agreement does not require any City of Des Moines funds. City Staff will need to perform final inspection of the improvements located within the City of Des Moines, to ensure compliance with submitted plans and specifications.
