AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of Amendment #1 for the FFY 2009 WMD SWAT Task Force Program Grant.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Amendment #1 for the FFY 2009 WMD SWAT Task Force Program Grant to change the end date of the performance period from March 31, 2012 to June 30, 2012. The Iowa Homeland Security and Emergency Management Director has requested the City of Des Moines serve as the fiscal agent and authorized representative for the administration of Iowa’s FFY 2009 Homeland Security Grant Program funds on behalf of Iowa’s Weapons of Mass Destruction Tactical Officer’s (SWAT) Task Force Program.

This extension will provide the time to complete the training and state-wide exercises identified and approved by the Task Force Leadership Committee and complete the required reimbursement claims and progress report.
