**AGENDA HEADING:**

Approving purchase of replacement snow and ice control equipment and additional wing snow plows.

**SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of the purchase of snow and ice control equipment and related accessories, hydraulics and control systems to be installed on heavy duty diesel truck chassis for use by the Department of Public Works for emergency snow and ice control operations and year round scheduled operations from Henderson Truck Equipment 916 South 10th Street, Manchester, Iowa, 52057, Marty Ward, President, in the amount of \$610,269.00.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

This recommended emergency snow and ice control operations equipment consists of 13 front mounted snow plow, 12 wing plows, 12 dump bodies, one multi-purpose dump body, a material spreader and associated accessories, hydraulic systems, and control systems to be installed on 13 heavy duty trucks recommended for award under separate action. This will result in an addition of 12 wing plows in the City’s fleet for emergency snow and ice control operations. One unit that is utilized for year round alley maintenance and emergency spill response will not be equipped with a wing plow. Five existing stainless steel material spreaders are being reused on new chassis to maintain an adequate number of material spreaders for emergency snow and ice control operations while reducing acquisition costs.
