ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The contract for the construction of the 33rd Street Sewer Separation project was awarded to Reilly Construction Co., Inc. and Subsidiaries, in the amount of \$1,485,199.10. This construction contract includes installation of manholes, intakes, 15-inch through 42-inch storm sewer, 8-inch and 10-inch sanitary sewer, replacement of street pavement, sidewalks, and other related items to separate the combined sewer at 33rd Street and several other locations west of downtown.

Change Order No. 9 compensates the contractor for additional work due to unforeseen site conditions such as: numerous areas of severely deteriorated pavement structure; the required abandonment of undocumented existing sewer pipe; the removal and replacement of unstable soils; and the replacement of non-compliant sewer service and water service connections. Additional pavement removal and replacement was completed on 35th Street north of Ingersoll Avenue, Kingman Boulevard from 40th Street to 45th Street, and 37th Street from Kingman Boulevard to Cottage Grove Avenue to minimize future inconvenience to the residents. The work included in Change Order No. 9 will be added to this contract by extending the contract bid item quantities and honoring the bid item unit pricing in the contract.
