# **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approval of Grant Agreements with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for funding of the City's Third Year (2012) Action Plan of the 2010-2014 HUD Consolidated Plan.

### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend Council approval of grant agreements by and between HUD and the City of Des Moines, whereby the City will receive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership program (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding (grant awards) for the implementation of the Third Year (period of January 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012). Action Plan of the 2010- 2014 HUD Consolidated Plan.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$4,409,207

<u>Funding Source</u>: FY 2012-2013 Operating Budget, Community Development: Special Revenue Funds, SP020 CDD049900, Community Development Block Grant Fund, Page 57; SP036 CDD049900, HOME Fund, Page 57; SP039 CDD049900, Homeless Fund, Page 57.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

At the City Council meeting on November 7, 2011, the Council approved the Third (2012) Year Action Plan of the 2010-2014 HUD Consolidated Plan including the recommended funding allocations, consisting of CDBG, HOME, and ESG funding.

From 2011 to 2012, funding for CDBG has reduced by \$507, 061; funding for HOME has reduced by \$210,166; and funding for ESG increased by \$144,952.

In order to receive HUD draw downs we have to process the Grant Agreements.
