AGENDA HEADING:

Approval to purchase systems furniture workstations and office furniture along with seating, shelving, filing cabinets, task lighting, and tables to be installed in the Fire Department Administration, Maintenance and Training Facility.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval for the purchase of systems furniture workstations and office furniture along with seating, shelving, filing cabinets, task lighting, and tables to be installed in the new Fire Department Administration, Maintenance, and Training Facility under construction. The furniture is needed to replace existing non-ergonomic desks and chairs.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$168,407.17

Funding Source: 2012-2013 CIP, Page Fire-8, Maintenance/Logistics & Training Campus, FIR038.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The construction of the Fire Department Administration, Maintenance, and Training Facility is anticipated to be completed by September 2012. The new facility replaces the existing facilities at the Central Fire Station and the Lomar Building, which are functionally obsolete and structurally in need of significant repairs. The Fire Department will improve the delivery of its administration, support, and maintenance functions by consolidating at the new location. The new furnishings offer better ergonomic features and more efficient use of space.

The purchase and installation of the furnishings is being purchased from Pigott, Inc., 3815 Ingersoll Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa 50312, through the U.S. Communities Agreement.

Municipal Code section 2-726(f) provides for the procurement of goods and/or services from contracts that have been competitively established through the Western States Contracting Alliance and other cooperative contracting consortiums for state government departments, institutions, agencies and political subdivisions, without conforming to the competitive bidding requirements of the Procurement Division.
