AGENDA HEADING:

Reprogramming and Carryover of prior years' unspent Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding and other funds for the 2012 HUD Consolidated Plan Programs.

SYNOPSIS:

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The following is an analysis of the funding estimates used to plan for the 2012 Program Year. Additionally, there is a breakdown of CDBG funds available for reprogramming and which programs will carryover funding to the 2012 Program Year. The funds available come from unspent 2010, 2011, and 2012 CDBG funds.

Administrative funds were not all spent because of additional funding from other sources, such as the Supportive Housing Program, a Department of Labor pass through grant, Neighborhood Stabilization Program and Disaster grants.

Staff is recommending the \$188,270.77 be allocated the following way:

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$36,638 – 2012 CDBG shortfall
$26,906.46 – Abandoned Homeless Camp Clean-up
$124,726.31 – Retained and allocated to 2013 programs during the annual planning
conference when more information on which to base funding decisions is
available.
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Furthermore, staff recommends the carryover of \$348,485.63 of CDBG and HOME funding from previous program years to the 2012 program year.
