AGENDA HEADING:

Public Hearing for the Proposed Amendment to the Third (2012) Year Action Plan of the 2010-2014 U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Consolidated Plan

SYNOPSIS:

This action is the Public Hearing for the Third (2012) year Action Plan of the 2010-2014 HUD Consolidated Plan as a result of a second allocation of federal entitlement Emergency Solution Grant (ESG) funding.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On December 5, 2011, HUD published the interim rule for the amended Emergency Solution Grant (ESG) program along with corresponding amendments to the Consolidated Plan regulations. The interim rule became effective on January 4, 2012. Some of the PY2012 ESG funds were held in reserve by HUD for distribution after publication of the interim rule in order to implement the new program guidelines. Entitlement cities will receive the additional allocation only after their Consolidated Plans are amended and approved by HUD.
