Hearing on Gray's Lake Trail Connection: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Corell Contractor, Inc., Grant S. Corell, President, 1300 Lincoln Street, West Des Moines, Iowa, 50265 \$282,308.70.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Gray's Lake Trail Connection and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project will provide a safer bicycle and pedestrian connection between several south side neighborhoods and the City's trail system and Gray's Lake Park.

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: \$282,308.70 Construction Contract (\$293,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2012-2013 CIP, Page Park - 16, Recreation Trails, PKS045, Being: \$211,731.53 in Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) State Recreational Trails funding (75% eligible construction costs, a maximum of \$439,920), Agreement 2012-RT-007; \$41,000 Gray's Lake Neighborhood Association donations; with the remaining \$29,577.17 from PKS045, G.O. Bonds.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On June 11, 2012, under Roll Call No. 12-0858, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Gray's Lake Trail Connection. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Gray's Lake Trail Connection, 11-2011-003. The improvement includes construction of a ten (10) foot wide hot mix asphalt trail six (6) inches thick, earthwork, clearing and grubbing, culverts, and other incidental items; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plans File Nos. 545-037/072, along Thomas Beck Road from Casady Drive to 2,500 feet east and then north to the American Discovery Trail and Gray's Lake Park, Des Moines, Iowa.

Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

Corell Contractor, Inc., West Des Moines, Iowa Grimes Asphalt & Paving Corp., Des Moines, Iowa OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Des Moines, Iowa Elder Corporation, Des Moines, Iowa MPS Engineers, P.C., Des Moines, Iowa T K Concrete Inc., Pella, Iowa

The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on June 28, 2012.

The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Corell Contractor, Inc., in the amount of \$282,308.70, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
