**AGENDA HEADING:**

Hearing on 2012 Expanded Street Resurfacing Program - Contract 1: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer’s estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt & Paving Corp., Kurt Rasmussen, President, \$1,010,680.

**SYNOPSIS:**

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2012 Expanded Street Resurfacing Program - Contract 1 and take the necessary actions, as required by Iowa Code, to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the placement of hot mix asphalt (HMA) overlay on streets citywide to address citizen concerns regarding the condition of city streets by preserving deteriorating infrastructure and to improve the ride.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

June 25, 2012, under Roll Call No. 12-0961, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2012 Expanded Street Resurfacing Program - Contract 1. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2012 Expanded Street Resurfacing Program - Contract 1, 06-2012-003. The improvement includes scarification of existing streets, furnish and place Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA), and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 546-66/80, at the following locations within the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

- East 16th Street from Dean Avenue to Lyon Street
- 39th Street from Franklin Avenue to Hickman Road
- 40th Place from Adams Avenue to Amick Avenue
- 44th Street from Hickman Road to Urbandale Avenue
- 52nd Street from Urbandale Avenue to Douglas Avenue
- Center Street from 42nd Street to 800 feet west
- Douglas Avenue from 2nd Avenue to Cornell Street

Franklin Avenue from M. L. King Jr. Parkway to 16th Street  
Indianapolis Avenue from E. 37th Street to E. 41st Street  
Walker Street from East 15th Street to Dixon Street  
Woodland Avenue from M. L. King Jr. Parkway to 15th Street.

Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

Grimes Asphalt & Paving Corp., Des Moines, Iowa  
OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Des Moines, Iowa

The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on July 10, 2012.

The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Grimes Asphalt & Paving Corp., Kurt Rasmussen, President, 5550 NE 22nd Street, P.O. Box 3374, Des Moines, Iowa, 50313 in the amount of \$1,010,680, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
