AGENDA HEADING:

Authorizing execution and delivery of a Supplement No. 3, in the principal amount of \$1,880,000 to the governmental lease-purchase master agreement between the City of Des Moines and Wells Fargo Bank, N.A.

SYNOPSIS:

Council previously approved the acquisition of nine (9) dump trucks, an asphalt paver, and a compact motor grader and also held a public hearing on the financing of the acquisitions through a lease purchase arrangement. This action will complete the process to finance the acquisitions as Supplement No. 3 through the master lease agreement approved in July of 2011, with Wells Fargo Bank, N.A.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$1,880,000, plus interest over ten years

Funding Source: DS001 FIN900100 Debt Service Administration

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The City utilizes the lease-purchase program from time to time to finance vehicles and equipment as a means to avoid large one-time cash expenditures. Recently, the City utilized the master lease agreement to purchase vactor trucks for the Sanitary Sewer Enterprise. These replacement trucks, asphalt paver, and compact motor grader represent the large vehicle needs for the next 18 months with the next group of lease-purchased trucks expected early in 2014. Smaller vehicles will be purchased on a pay-as-you-go basis with available budgeted cash.

In April 2012, a public hearing was held to consider lease purchase of the above equipment. The lease purchase arrangement is consistent with the planned financing of the equipment acquisition. Supplement No. 3 is related to vehicles and rolling stock to be used by Public Works.
