AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Change Order No. 3 with Elder Corporation for a reduced thickness pavement section on top of the levee for the Des Moines River Regional Trail - Phase 1 for a reduction of \$34,152.00.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Change Order No. 3 for a reduction of \$34,152.00 with Elder Corporation, Jared R. Elder II, President, 5088 E. University Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa 50327, for a reduced thickness pavement section on top of the levee for the Des Moines River Regional Trail – Phase 1.

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: \$34,152.00 (reduction)

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2012-2013 CIP, Page Parks-16, Recreation Trails, PKS045, Being: \$426,526 maximum in Federal funds from Iowa Clean Air Attainment Program (ICAAP) for 80% eligible construction costs under IDOT Project No. STP-A-1945(773)--86-77; \$73,474 in Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) State Recreational Trails funding, Agreement 2010-SRT-004; \$300,000 Iowa DNR REAP Grant, Agreement 08-R4-QV; \$163,400 from 165 individual, business and foundation pledges; \$25,000 Polk County Community Development Grant award; and the remaining funding from PKS045, G.O. Bonds.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Des Moines River Regional Trail – Phase 1 was awarded on February 13, 2012 in an amount of \$1,364,999.99 to Elder Corporation. The improvement includes construction of a 5-inch and 6-inch HMA Recreational Trail from Scott Street to the James W. Cownie Baseball Park, along the south side of the Des Moines River. The estimated construction cost was \$1,800,000.00. The low bid was \$435,000.01 under the budget estimate.

The trail is located on DM-3 levee much of the length between SE 1st Street and east of SE 14th Street. Based on the Des Moines River Flood Mitigation report that DM-3 levee will not meet the required freeboard, AECOM Technical Services, Inc. was approved on February 13, 2012 to provide professional services to evaluate incorporating an increase in the height of the DM-3 levee system as part of the trail construction.

The consultant has prepared a plan for raising the levee. These plans were submitted to the Corps of Engineers. Due to required Corps of Engineers 408 approval process and additional hydraulics

required, the levee raise could not be incorporated into the Des Moines River Regional Trail – Phase 1 project. Grant dollars already specified to be used for the trail project will be lost if not used; therefore, Change Order 3 has been negotiated with the contractor to install a reduced pavement section knowing that a future levee raise will be necessary for DM-3. These proposed trail improvements will still help in future flood-fighting operations by providing better access to the levee. The information and analysis required by the Corps of Engineers for the 408 process will be prepared and included in a future submittal that addresses the entire levee system and proposed improvements.
