AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Schedule of Fees amendment for Electrical, Mechanical and Plumbing Permit base fee increases.

SYNOPSIS:

Amend the Schedule of Fees, by increasing the base fee for electrical, mechanical and plumbing permits from \$35.00 to \$50.00 to better cover Permit and Development Center (PDC) operating costs. The base fee has not changed since the adoption of the Schedule of Fees in late 2002.

FISCAL IMPACT: NONE

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

This proposed fee increase was made a part of the adopted FY '12-'13 budget reduction proposal. The revenue generated in FY '11-'12 from permits associated with electrical, mechanical and plumbing systems covered approximately 78% of PDC operating costs. A permit base fee increase of \$15.00 would have generated revenue covering approximately 89% of PDC costs during that same time period.
